Dr. Walker took care of my mother, Florence Southwell Gomez, when she had typhoid fever in 1925 at age 18.

She nearly died from the typhoid and was in the quarantine ward at Sharon Hospital for over six weeks. Mom told us many stories about how kind Dr. Walker was to her during her long ordeal. Her father had just died the month before (leaving four children, the youngest of which was only three years old), and the family was in emotional turmoil. She remembered how Dr. Walker stayed by her bedside through the worst of her illness and how solicitous he was toward her mother throughout that whole difficult period.

When she finally was well enough to come home, Dr. Walker actually drove her home from the hospital in his own car.
